Go South for about 36km. Just past McKenzie (Laird) Lake, Sign on the right.

From the East; Cross the bridge coming into Princeton, turn right (Petro Can) onto Bridge Street.
Take next right onto Highway 5a. North for 20km, Sign on your left.

From the West: Just Past the A&W, turn left onto Bridge Street, Next right onto Highway 5a,
North for 20km, Sign on the left.

Watch for footprints

Students must come field ready, and prepared for all types of weather.
